A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 2.81 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10624. The date of priority is JANUARY 16, 1985. This right is limited to 0.035 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL WELL: NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 31, T 15 S, R 11 E, W.M.; 80 FEET SOUTH AND 2290 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 31), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of appropriation from the source.

The well is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 31, T 15 S, R 11 E, W.M.; 1019 FEET NORTH AND 753 FEET WEST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 2.81 ACRES
SECTION 31
TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.


The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation.

When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 29, 2001, approving Transfer Application 8795, and together with Certificate 78318, supersedes Certificate 65886, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
