confirms the right to use the waters of UNNAMED STREAM AND EILERTSON CREEK, TRIBUTARIES OF WESTPORT SLOUGH, for DOMESTIC USE FOR 9 HOUSEHOLDS INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF ONE-HALF ACRE OF LAWN OR NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN FOR EACH HOUSEHOLD FROM EILERTSON CREEK, WITH ANY DEFICIENCY IN AVAILABLE SUPPLY FROM THE UNNAMED STREAM; AND DOMESTIC USE FOR TWO HOUSEHOLDS INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF ONE-HALF ACRE OF LAWN OR NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN FOR EACH HOUSEHOLD FROM UNNAMED STREAM .

This right was perfected under Permit S-44553. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 10, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.
