A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of the UMATILLA RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 36.0 ACRES.

This right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 3, at Page 127. The date of priority is December 26, 1904.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.45 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, subject to the provisions of paragraph 33 of said decree, (IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION BEING LOCATED NORTH 52 DEGREES EAST 2110 FEET FROM SW CORNER, Section 2, T 2 N, R 30 E, W.M.), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source, subject to the provisions of paragraph 33 of said decree and all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

DIVERSION 3: NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 15, T 2 N, R 31 E, W.M.; 1000 FEET SOUTH AND 690 FEET EAST FROM THE W 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 15.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.45 cubic foot per second.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 11.0 ACRES
SW 1/4 SW 1/4 7.1 ACRES
SECTION 15

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 16.3 ACRES
SE 1/4 SE 1/4 1.6 ACRES
SECTION 16

TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 31 EAST, W.M.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;


the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEPTEMBER 19, 1986, approving Transfer Application 5773, and together with Certificate 55329, supersedes Certificate 35280, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
