CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

Killamacue Land Reservoir and Rock Creek Irrigation Company  
Haines, Oregon 97833

confirms the right to use the waters of KILLAMACUE LAKE AND RESERVOIR for STORAGE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is August 22, 1900.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled to be stored and used each year under this right is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 311.76 ACRE FEET.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 4282, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of Administrative Law Judge Weisha Mize, entered September 18, 1996, and recorded in Special Order Volume 50, Page 592, approving partial cancellation and supercedes Certificate 4282.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
