NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.

CONDITIONS OF USE

1. The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
2. The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.
3. The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.
4. All flashboards are to be removed from the spillway during the period October 1 to March 1 of each year.
5. The structure shall be modified under supervision of a registered engineer licensed in Oregon.
6. The structure shall be constructed, operated, and maintained in accordance with the approved plans and specifications and within the design intent.
7. The outlet gate shall be cycled at least once each year in order to assure smooth operation.
8. The embankment and spillway channel shall be kept clear of trees and brush and other debris.
9. The embankment shall be kept free of burrowing animals.
