

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the SPRAGUE RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 1.3 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 307.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10126. The date of priority is MARCH 28, 1983. This right is limited to 3.85 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 24, T 36 S, R 14 E, W.M.; 1510 FEET NORTH AND 1750 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 24.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.


The works shall include an airline and pressure gauge or an access port for a measuring line, adequate to determine the water level elevation in the well at all times.

The water user shall maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

In the event that rights are determined in the Klamath Adjudication for the lands, source, and use(s) involved in this right, the Department will, following review of the rights, proceed to modify or cancel those portions of this right duplicated by the decreed right.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.
