 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of JOB RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-6335, a tributary of THE TUALATIN RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 18.42 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-50740. The date of priority is MAY 17, 1988. This right is limited to NOT MORE THAN 5.4 ACRE-FEET OF STORED WATER ONLY, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 68698, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 28, 2007 approving Transfer Application T-10265.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
