Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STEPHEN & LAIDEE ANN WOLFE

confirms the right to use the waters of the UMATILLA RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 17.48 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 20389. The date of priority is JUNE 18, 1951. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.437 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (IF LAWFULLY AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION BEING LOCATED IN THE NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 31 EAST, W.M.), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.437 CFS.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 16, T 2 N, R 31 E, W.M.; 680 FEET SOUTH AND 470 FEET EAST FROM THE CENTER 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 16.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent

for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 7.48 ACRES
NW 1/4 SE 1/4 10.00 ACRES
SECTION 16
TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 31 EAST, W.M.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;


the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEPTEMBER 19, 1986, approving Transfer Application 5774, and supersedes Certificate 21304, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
