CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the WALLA WALLA RIVER, a tributary of the SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 4.5 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UMATILLA COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 12, at Page 9. The date of priority is 1894.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed ONE AND ONE-HALF MINER'S INCHES PER ACRE provided the total diverted does not exceed 0.11 CUBIC-FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

MILTON DITCH: SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SECTION 18, T 5 N, R 36 E, WM.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


