CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ARTHUR TAUBE
WONDER, OR 97543

confirms the right to use the waters of SLATE CREEK, tributary to APPLGATE RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 1.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-15751. The date of priority is APRIL 13, 1944. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2 to October 31 of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

The West 30 acres of the as SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, Township 37 South, Range 7 West, W.M., Josephine County.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 15628, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 27, 2007, approving Transfer Application 9141.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
