This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RUSSMAR COMPANY, JACK RUSSELL c/o CASCADE CATTLE COMPANY 1155 SOUTH FORK LITTLE BUTTE CREEK ROAD EAGLE POINT, OREGON 97524

confirms the right to use the waters of WEST FORK LAKE CREEK, EAST FORK LAKE CREEK, AND LAKE CREEK RESERVIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-3232, tributaries of LITTLE BUTTE CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 836.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 28688. The date of priority is APRIL 18, 1963. This right is limited to 10.45 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 5.25 CFS FROM WEST FORK AND 5.20 CFS FROM EAST FORK, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

EAST FORK: SW4 NE4, SECTION 17, T 37 S, R 2 E, WM; 2340 FEET SOUTH AND 2750 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 17.

RESERVOIR: SW4 SE4, SECTION 6, T37 S, R 2 E, WM; 440 FEET NORTH AND 850 FEET EAST FROM THE S4 CORNER, SECTION 6.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second from each acre irrigated from direct flow(or its equivalent) and 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage, provided further that the right to use of direct flow shall be limited to the period when the flow of the Rogue River is more than 1000 cfs immediately above Savage Rapids Dam, more than 1000 cfs at Raygold, and more than 735 cfs at its mouth and the flow of Little Butte Creek is more than 31 cfs at its mouth.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
