This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

confirms the right to use the waters of LOST, HARRISON, CHARLEY AND COON CREEKS, AND 535.0 ACRE FEET FROM BRADSHAW RESERVOIR, constructed under Permit R-4747, tributaries of the SOUTH FORK LITTLE BUTTE CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 338.9 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 913.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 31268. The date of priority is JULY 5, 1966. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 14.52 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

BRADSHAW RESERVOIR: NWW SWW4, SECTION 1, T 37 S, R 1 E, WM; 650 FEET SOUTH AND 1130 FEET EAST FROM THE WW CORNER, SECTION 1.

LOST CREEK: SW4 NE4, SECTION 29, T 37 S, R 2 E, WM; 1650 FEET SOUTH AND 2650 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 27.

HARRISON CREEK: NE¼ NE¼, SECTION 28, T 37 S, R 2 EAST, WM; 980 FEET SOUTH AND 450 FEET WEST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 27.

CHARLEY CREEK: NE¼ NW¼, SECTION 28, T 37 S, R 2 E, WM; 50 FEET SOUTH AND 850 FEET WEST FROM THE N¼ CORNER, SECTION 28.

COON CREEK: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 20, T 37 S, R 2 E, WM; 400 FEET NORTH FROM THE E $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 20.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4½ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from April 2 to October 31 from direct flow and storage.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
