## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of EAGLE CREEK, tributary to the POWDER RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 150.6 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is 1881.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed ONE-FORTIETH OF ONE CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND PER ACRE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 49435, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered approving Transfer Application T-9979 for a change in point of diversion and partial cancellation of a water right.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
