CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

HAROLD E. AKES

MILTON-FREEWATER, OR 97862

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL, within the EAST BRANCH MUD CREEK BASIN (Walla Walla River), for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 32.58 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-1469. The date of priority is MAY 25, 1959. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.18 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The point of appropriation is located as follows:

6 N	35 E	WM	27	NE NW	743 FEET SOUTH AND 1672 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 27

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be subject to the provisions of the order recorded in Vol. 10, page 243 - 245, Special Order Record of the State Water Resources Director.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 30743, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUN 15 2007, approving Transfer Application T-9978.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
