 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

T.R. PARKER
 BOX 84
 ALAMO, CA

confirms the right to use the waters of BEAR CREEK, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 41.45 acres and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 1.1 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit 19282. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 27, 1950. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.43 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows: SW¼ NE¼, SE¼ NW¼, as projected within Kahler DLC 49, Section 20, T. 36 S., R. 2 W., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2 to October 31 of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
