CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

W. A. MACK
KERBY OR 97531

confirms the right to use the waters of ALTHOUSE CREEK (through Hunt and Lischen Ditch), tributary to EAST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 16.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-4453. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 20, 1920. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.20 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 6113, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 01 2007, approving Transfer Application T-8126 for a change in point of diversion and partial cancellation of a water right.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
