 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

J. L. CALVERT H. M. YARBROUGH
 GRANTS PASS, OR KERBY, OR

confirms the right to use the waters of the JUNCTION OF ILLINOIS RIVER, SUCKER CREEK AND ALTHOUSE CREEK, tributaries to the ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 115.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-1107. The date of priority is MARCH 5, 1912. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.45 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 57716, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 01 2007, approving Transfer Application T-8126 for a change in point of diversion and partial cancellation of a water right.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
