CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

Clarence G. Huff
HALFWAY OR 97834

confirms the right to use the waters of WASTE WATER and DRAINAGE from swamps in Sections 29 and 32, T7S R46E, W.M., for IRRIGATION of 68.0 ACRES and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 39.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-8806. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 19, 1928. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.34 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
