## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of EAST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, tributary to ILLINOIS RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 5.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 13, at Page 70. The date of priority is MAY, 1887.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1<sup>st</sup> to November 1<sup>st</sup> of each year or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:
