CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

A. G. CROY
KERBY OR 97531

confirms the right to use the waters of EAST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, tributary to ILLINOIS RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 5.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 13, at Page 70. The date of priority is MAY, 1887.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1st to November 1st of each year or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 80885, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 3rd, 2007, approving Transfer Application T-9532.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
