This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CRAIG COLEMAN 33896 E. WALLS ROAD HERMISTON, OREGON 97838

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS in the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 32.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-1671. The date of priority is JUNE 28, 1960. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.4 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, being 0.4 CFS from either well in any combination, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation; Well 1.

The wells are located as follows:

WELL # 1: NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 27, T 4 N, R 27 E, W.M.; 1420 FEET NORTH AND 490 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 27.

WELL #1a: NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 27, T 4 N, R 27 E, W.M.; 1350 FEET NORTH AND 430 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 6.0 ACRES SECTION 27

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 26.0 ACRES SECTION 36
TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 27 EAST, W.M.

The wells shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated.

The former place of use shall no longer receive water under the original authorized use of this water right.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE and an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 24, 2004, and supersedes Certificate 80596, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The order contained an error in the description of the proposed place of use. The order indicated that the proposed place of use was to be located in Section 36. The application map submitted in support of the application indicated that the proposed place of use was to be located in Section 27. This certificate is issued to reflect the location of use as being within Section 27.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
