 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GEORGE & EDWIN BURKHALTER
 ROUTE 5
 HILLSBORO OR 97123

confirms the right to use the waters of an UNNAMED CREEK and A RESERVOIR (constructed under Permit R-1205) tributaries to TUALATIN RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 4.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-20547. The date of priority is MAY 21, 1951. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.052 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the stream.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-1205. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
