CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS in the Scappoose Bay Basin for INDUSTRIAL USES AT ARMSTRONG CEILING TILE PLANT TO INCLUDE WATER FOR MIXING WITH PROCESS MATERIALS, GENERAL MILL USES, AND MAINTAINING PRESSURIZED FIRE SUPPRESSION SYSTEMS.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10892. The date of priority is MARCH 2, 1989. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 500.00 GALLONS PER MINUTE (GPM), BEING 500.00 GPM FROM WELL 1 AND 350.00 GPM FROM WELL 2 or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The use of water shall be limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with prior surface water rights as well as prior ground water rights of others.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.

Each well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge to determine the water level elevation in the well at all times.

The water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device and keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.
