This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This right was perfected under Permit G-3560. The date of priority is JANUARY 16, 1967. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.
