CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the LITTLE PUDDING RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 3.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-3560. The date of priority is JANUARY 16, 1967. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The well is located as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within LAMBERT DLC 61, SECTION 8, T 6 S, R 2 W, WM; 2220 FEET SOUTH AND 1000 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER, LAMBERT DLC 61.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.
