 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

AUGUST ZAUGG
 UNION, OR 97883

confirms the right to use the waters of CATHERINE CREEK, tributary to GRANDE RONDE RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 39.65 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-12308. The date of priority is AUGUST 13, 1936. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.5 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 12036, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUL 13 2007 and recorded at Special Order Volume 72, Page 633, cancelling a portion of the water right. This certificate supersedes Certificate 12036.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

After the expiration of fifty years from the date of this certificate or on the expiration of any federal power license issued in connection with this right, and after not less than two years notice in writing to the holder hereof, the State of Oregon, or any municipality thereof, shall have the right to take over the dams, plans and other structures and all appurtenances thereto which have been constructed for the purpose of devoting to beneficial use the water rights specified herein, upon condition that before taking possession the State or municipality shall pay not to exceed the fair value of the property so taken, plus such reasonable damages, if any, to valuable, serviceable and dependable property to the holder of this certificate, not taken over, as may be caused by the severance therefrom of the property taken in accordance with the provisions of section 47-508, Oregon Code 1930.
