CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

O. R. HEAVILIN STAR ROUTE SILVER LAKE, OREGON 97638

confirms the right to use the waters of WELLS 1 AND 2 in the FORT ROCK BASIN for IRRIGATION of 226.4 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit G-7054. The date of priority is December 14, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 2.835 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, being 1.07 cfs from Well 1 and 1.765 cfs from Well 2, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

- Well 1-NE 4 SE 4, Section 3, T27S, R15S, WM; 1120 feet South and 760 feet West from the E 4 Corner of Section 3; and
- Well 2-NE 1 NW 1, Section 3, T27S, R15S, WM; 1273 feet South and 2645 feet West from the NE Corner of Section 3.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
