CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

G. W. THRASHER
KERBY, OR 97531

confirms the right to use the waters of EAST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 0.75 ACRE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the Sate of Oregon for Josephine County and said decree entered of record at Salem in the Order Record of the State Engineer in Volume 13 at page 70. The date of priority is MAY, 1887. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed one cubic foot per second for each 50 acres of land irrigated during the irrigation season form April 1 to November 1 of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 13926, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered 7-20-2007 and recorded in Special Order Volume 72, Page 747 approving a partial cancellation and supersedes Certificate 13926.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
