CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

Charles A. Harville
Richland, Oregon

confirms the right to use the waters of EAGLE CREEK, tributary to the POWDER RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 35.91 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Enlargement Permit 142, entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of the State Water Board at Salem in Volume 1 at page 284 on April 10, 1918. The date of priority is JUNE 10, 1912.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.45 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 81558, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of Water Resources Director in PC 03-06, entered July 12, 2007, and recorded in Special Order Volume 72, Pages 583 - 593, approving partial cancellation and supercedes 81558.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
