 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GEORGE F. WOLFF
 MYRTLE CREEK OR 97457

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED SPRING, tributary of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 0.3 acre, STOCK AND DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY.

This right was perfected under Permit S-38522. The date of priority is JULY 14, 1974. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.015 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (cfs), being 0.005 cfs for each use or its equivalent in case of rotation measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of one eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


