CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the ROGUE RIVER, tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION of 2.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 298. The date of priority is JULY 26, 1909. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.013 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, if available at the old point of diversion: LOT 4 (NW¼ SE¼), SECTION 17, T 35 S, R 1 W, WM; 960 FEET SOUTH AND 3370 FEET EAST FROM THE W14, SECTION 17, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
