CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That EIGUREN & NAVARRO

has a right to the use of

the waters of Jordan Creek

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Nalhour County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 9, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1866 for Tract #1; 1830 for Tract #2; and 1891 for Tract #3

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2 acre feet per acre prior to June 1st, and & acre foot per acre furing any calendar month after June 1st, of each irrigation season from April 1st to October 15th.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

- TRACT #1: 20 acres in SR15W1, 20 acres in SW15R1, Section 26, T. 30 S., R. 42 E., W.M., being a total of 40 acres.
- TRACT #2: 20 acres in NE3SW1, 10.3 acres in NW1SW2, 10 acres in SW1SW1, 13.2 acres in SE1SW1, 5 acres in NE3SE1, 20 acres in NW1SE1, 5.7 acres in SW1SE1, 39.5 acres in SE1SE1, Section 26, 13.2 acres in NE3NE1, Section 35, T. 30 S., R. 42 E., W.M., being a total of 135 acres.
- TRACT #5: 22.7 acres in NE SE4, 1.1 acres in NW SE4, Section 27, 4.1 acres in SE4NW4, 24.9 acres in NW SW4, 19.8 acres in NE SW4, 17.5 acres in NW SE4, Section 26, T. 30 S., R. 42 E., V.M., being a total of 90.1 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
