CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

G. L. McMILLAN, S. G. McMILLAN and J. F. McMILLAN  
Lexington, OR 97839

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLOW CREEK, tributary to the COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 1.0 ACRE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Morrow County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at page 73. The date of priority is 1901.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, and is limited to the irrigation season MARCH 1 to JULY 1 of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 167, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 17, 2007, approving Transfer Application T-10170, and together with Certificate 83475, supersedes Certificate 167.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
