CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILSON DITCH CO.
501 FULLERTON RD
ECHO, OREGON 97826

confirms the right to use the waters of UMATILLA RIVER, tributary to COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 73.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 3, at Page 127. The date of priority is MAY, 1881 FOR 10.0 ACRES, AND DECEMBER 15, 1904 FOR 63.0 ACRES.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.91 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, (CFS), BEING 0.13 CFS WITH A PRIORITY DATE OF MAY 1881 FOR THE IRRIGATION OF 10.0 ACRES AND 0.78 CFS WITH A PRIORITY DATE OF DECEMBER 15, 1904 FOR THE IRRIGATION OF 63.0 ACRES, (if available at the original point of diversion described as the Wilson Ditch), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The water user shall install and maintain headgates, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The water user shall report total flow figures when requested by the Department. The Watermaster may operate the headgates and monitor accuracy of the measuring devices, as needed.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 81586, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOV 30 2007, approving Transfer Application T-10009.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
