CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of DESCHUTES RIVER, tributary to COLUMBIA RIVER, for instream use for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat and other ecological values.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Deschutes County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 9, at Page 362. The date of priority is SPRING of 1885. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.113 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND from APRIL 1 through OCTOBER 31.

The description of the stream reach in which flows are to be maintained is as follows:

From the location of the diversion authorized previously under Certificate 83243, located at:


To LAKE BILLY CHINOOK (RM 120).

The instream right established by this Allocation of Conserved Water shall replace a portion of instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.341 or 537.346 and shall be in addition to instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.348 or 537.470 unless otherwise specified by a subsequent order establishing a new instream water right.

The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 83243, and any related decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ALLOCATION OF CONSERVED WATER approved by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 73, Page 212, approving conserved water application CW-43 and together with Certificates 83520 and 83521 supercedes Certificate 83243, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
