CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

David S. Blair
Route 1, Box 100
Rogue River, Oregon 97537

confirms the right to use the waters of Mays Creek, tributary to Evans Creek, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 31.8 ACRES, DOMESTIC USE FOR 1 FAMILY AND STOCK.

This right was perfected under Permit S-24619. The date of priority is December 4, 1956. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.42 cubic foot per second (cfs), being 0.40 cfs for supplemental irrigation, 0.01 cfs for domestic and 0.01 cfs for stock, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


DOMESTIC USE FOR 1 FAMILY AND STOCK

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 24152, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOV 28 2007, approving Transfer Application 10395.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
