CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That JEROME LONG

of Jordan Valley, State of Oregon has a right to the use of

the waters of Jordan Creek and Trout Creek for Tracts Nos. 1 and 2; Jordan Creek for Tract No. 3; and Willow and Rye Grass Lands, Tract No. 4 for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 9, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1873 for Tracts Nos. 1 and 2; 1875 for Tract #3; Tract #4 without date of priority

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2 acre feet per acre prior to June 1st, and 1/2 acre foot per acre during any calendar month after June 1st, of each irrigation season from April 1st to October 15th, for Tracts Nos. 1, 2, and 3

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

TRACT #1: Lots 5 and 6, Block 7, and 1 acre in Lot 5, Block 8, Pioneer Addition to Town of Jordan Valley, Oregon. (Being in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 2, T. 30 S., R. 46 E., W.M.)

TRACT #2: 20.7 acres in NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 11, T. 30 S., R. 46 E., W.M.

TRACT #3: 39.5 acres in SE 1/4 NE 1/4, 38 acres in NE 1/4 SE 1/4, 32.5 acres in SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 11, 2.4 acres in NE 1/4 NE 1/4, 8.2 acres in NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 14, T. 30 S., R. 46 E., W.M., being a total of 120.6 acres.

TRACT #4: The following are Willow and Rye Grass lands, allowed a right by said decree, without date of priority, with the provision that such lands should be entitled to 2 acre feet of water per acre prior to June 1st of each year, and should not receive water thereafter:

19.3 acres in NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 11, T. 30 S., R. 46 E., W.M.

(Tract 3 -) Ch. Pt. of Div. Sp. Or. No. 110-892.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
