CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of May Creek and reservoir constructed under Permit R-872, tributary to Evans Creek, for IRRIGATION OF 13.3 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 21.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-17593. The date of priority is March 6, 1947. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.44 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2 to October 31 of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-872 and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
