CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

Streets, Bagley and Saunders
Ashland, Oregon 97520

confirms the right to use the waters of May Creek, tributary to Evans Creek, for IRRIGATION OF 28.5 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1901.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.408 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 51335, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOV 28 2007, approving Transfer Application 10395.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
