CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOSEPH B. AND CHRISTINE E. DOBBYN TRAIL, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of HOLE IN GROUND CREEK, tributary to the ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 2.0 ACRES, SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 5.0 ACRES, AND PUBLIC FOUNTAIN USE.

This right was perfected under Permit S-13794. The date of priority is JUNE 3, 1939. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.187 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.09 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION AND 0.097 CFS FOR PUBLIC FOUNTAIN USE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2 to October 31 of each year and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
