CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MCKENZIE RIVER GOLF COURSE INC.
P.O. BOX 98
WALTERVILLE, OR 97489

confirms the right to use the waters of HAUGEN CREEK, tributary to McKENZIE RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 35.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-51229. The date of priority is APRIL 3, 1990. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.44 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.


This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

This certificate correctly describes the place of use for that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 76393, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOV 30 2007, approving Transfer Application T-10017.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
