CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DAVID L AND RITA F HOGAN

confirms the right to use the waters of 2 WELLS in the FORT ROCK Basin for IRRIGATION of 257.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9127. The date of priority is JANUARY 13, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 3.22 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 1.61 CFS FROM EACH WELL, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW



A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied

This certificate is issued to correctly describe the place of use in the N½, Section 26, from Well 2, and supersedes Certificate 75535, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described
