

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SCOTT AND MARGIE RUNELS PO BOX 39 FORT ROCK, OREGON 97735

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 8 in the Fort Rock Basin for IRRIGATION of 1.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9125. The date of priority is JANUARY 13, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the original well: NW¼ SW¼, SECTION 3, T 25 S, R 16 E, WM; WELL 1 (now 8) 1340 FEET NORTH AND 1320 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 3, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation (wells), together with the quantity diverted at the old points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation.

When required by the Department the water user shall install in-line flow meters or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is to confirm changes in POINT OF APPROPRIATION and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director, entered March 20, 1998, at Special Order Volume 52, Page 200, approving Transfer 6864, and together with Certificate 75533, supersedes Certificate 53456, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.
