## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MILLER FORESTS, INC P.O. BOX 12395 SALEM, OREGON 97309

confirms the right to use the waters of the WILLAMETTE RIVER, tributary to the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 86.04 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-46657. The date of priority is DECEMBER 8, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.077 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion (well), together with that diverted at the original point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same source as the original point of diversion.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
