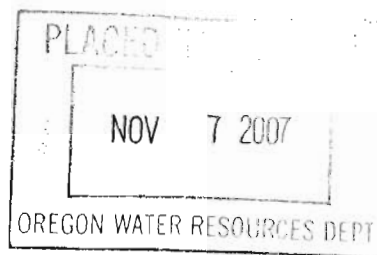

 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT



THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

OREGON TRAIL MOUNTAIN SPRING WATER; HOLMAN, KEN
 51244 OREGON TRAIL RD
 NORTH POWDER OR 97867

confirms the right to use the waters of PARKER SPRING, a tributary to Wolf Creek, for COMMERCIAL USE (WATER BOTTLING).

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for BAKER County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is 1871.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for Commercial Use (Water Bottling) is limited to 0.075 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for year-round use.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain headgate, an in-line flow meters, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The types and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.


This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN USE AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 29, 1999, approving Transfer Application 8095, and supersedes Certificate 4560, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.
