CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WALTER R. MILLER PO BOX 12395 SALEM, OR 97309

confirms the right to use the waters of SUCKER SLOUGH, a tributary to THOMAS CREEK and SMALLMAN CREEK, a tributary to the NORTH SANTIAM RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 301.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-37753. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 27, 1975. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 3.77 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS) FROM THE SLOUGH WHEN AVAILABLE WITH A DEFICIENCY IN THE AVAILABLE SUPPLY FROM THE SLOUGH TO BE MADE UP BY APPROPRIATION FROM SMALLMAN CREEK PROVIDED THAT THE QUANTITY DIVERTED FROM THE CREEK SHALL NOT EXCEED 0.94 CFS, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
