CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BUCKNER BROTHERS
 TERREBONNE OR 97760

confirms the right to use the waters of BUCKNER WELL 1, in the SMALL DRY CREEK (CROOKED RIVER) BASIN, for IRRIGATION of 107.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-442. The date of priority is DECEMBER 13, 1956. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.35 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of appropriation.

The point of appropriation is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued in accordance with OAR 690-OAR 690-380-6010 to describe the water right for a non-completed change in point of appropriation approved by of an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 9, 2002, at Special Order Volume 56, Page 32, approving transfer 6741 and supersedes Certificate 27107, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
