 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of APPELEGATE RIVER, tributary to ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 18.8 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 16, at Page 523. The date of priority is OCTOBER 1898.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.37 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion, if available at the original point of diversion, Bridgepoint Ditch, SW¼ SE¼, Section 17, T38S, R4W, W.M., 1075 feet North and 1660 feet West from the SE corner, Section 17.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. Said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 48666, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 29, 2008, approving Transfer Application T-9417.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
