 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MARGARET BRANDEIS AND JOEL BUCK
 4455 DEER CREEK ROAD
 SELMA, OR 97538

confirms the right to use the waters of BUCKSBERRY SUMP in the DEER CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATION of 0.7 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9921. The date of priority is AUGUST 18, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.009 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the original point of appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the sump.

The original point of appropriation location:

The point of appropriation is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (sump), together with the quantity of water diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain the approved device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated.


Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 24, 2006, at Special Order Volume 70, Page 645, approving Transfer Application 10174, and together with Certificate 82741 supersedes Certificate 66460, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with the prior surface water rights of others.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
