CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM A. SUNDAY

WINONA LAKE, INDIANA 46590

confirms the right to use the waters of NEAL CREEK, tributary to HOOD RIVER for IRRIGATION, LIVESTOCK AND DOMESTIC of 37.9 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Hood River County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 469. The date of priority is MARCH, 1901.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.4487 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 3846, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered DEC 13 2007, approving Transfer Application T-10416.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
